The Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival Modifies August 13 and 15th Performances

SANTA FE, N.M. — The Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival has modified two performances due to illness.

On Monday, August 13 at 6:00 p.m., mezzo-soprano Michelle DeYoung will join tenor Paul Groves on the Festival's presentation of Mahler's *Das Lied von der Erde* at the Lensic Performing Arts Center, replacing mezzo-soprano Sasha Cooke who is suffering from laryngitis.

Ms. Cooke also will not be singing Faure's *La chanson d'Ève* on Wednesday, August 15th at 6 p.m at the Lensic. The Faure will be replaced by Bach's *French Suite No. 5 in G Major, BWV 816* played by pianist Benjamin Hochman.
